INSTRUCTIONS: Each marching contingent, under the leadership of its Marshal, will assemble at the designated times at the point of assembly noted on this program. Each Marshal will report to the Division Commander and will be responsible for the conduct and orderliness of his or her group. Marching will consist of FOUR to SIX abreast.

PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 1:00 P.M. -- RAIN, SNOW OR SHINE

ROUTE of MARCH: Starting Point: McLean Avenue & Bronx River Road. West on McLean Ave. to Coyne Park (east of Central Park Ave). The Official Reviewing Stand will be located on the right side of McLean Avenue two blocks east of Coyne Park. Parade units will disband in Coyne Park upon order of the Marshals or leaders of the respective units.

MARCHING CONDUCT: Each contingent will maintain uniform ranks and endeavor to keep in step. Nothing of an unbecoming nature which detracts from the dignity of the parade will be permitted. This includes comic hats, advertising, posters and commercial signs. The carrying or consumption of alcoholic beverages while in the line of march is forbidden. Proper distance between units shall be maintained. NO gaps will be allowed. All marching units will exercise "EYES RIGHT" when passing the Reviewing Stand. We request that the bands play when passing the Reviewing Stand. NO stopping for demonstrations. All performances must keep moving FORWARD. Do not throw giveaway items at the spectators. Port-a-potties are located at the lineup area and along the line of march. The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) otherwise known as "Drones" is strictly prohibited. This includes all marching units, bands and spectators. The use of "selfie sticks" while marching is prohibited.
